





Mainly cenozonic land with proterozoic in the north, particularly rich in iron ore, Mauritania is Africa's second largest exporter. Other mineral deposits include tin, gold, copper, lead, chrome, phosphate, tungsten and chrome. There have also been recent discoveries of uranium and diamonds. Generally rising GDP growth over the past few years, with 2013 reported at 6.7%.

Niger's main export is uranium, found mainly in the central part of the country. Niger is also rich in gold to the east and west and is made up of a largely cenozoic landscape with areas of proterozoic and mosozoic in the central region and palaeozoic in the north east. GDP growth has significantly declined from 11.0% in 2012 to 4.1% in 2013.

Sudan's landscape is mixed; mesozoic, proterozoic, palaeozoic and cenozoic. There are iron and copper deposits towards the coastal eastern region, whilst gold can be found in the west. Since South Sudan gained independence in 2011, Sudan's GDP has taken a hit. The annual GDP growth has been performing negatively due to the separation however there has been an increase between 2012 and 2013.




